Naomi's passion for the natural world has led her to a career celebrating both the animal kingdom and the ocean through her art. With a mission to foster a deeper connection to nature and inspire conservation efforts, Naomi's work encourages us all to protect our natural world for future generations.

### WILDLIFE ART

Naomi is renowned for her highly detailed and realistic style, and her ability to capture personality and emotion in the animals she



draws. Her wildlife art often captures not just the animal but also their environment, creating immersive and captivating scenes that draw the viewer in. Her wildlife art is drawn primarily in pastels and features in collections around the world.

Naomi has been a Wildlife Artist of the Year finalist in both 2022 and 2024 and has exhibited her work at the Mall Galleries in London. She was recently awarded the Inaugural Chairperson's Award 2024 from the Association of Animal Artists in recognition of her wildlife art and contribution to conservation.
